June harvest

Two thirds of the beef animals have been harvested already.

I will harvest several more next week and then there will be a gap in harvesting of almost two weeks.

There are three reasons for that gap.

Some of you asked for your beef later in June.

Bison will be harvested near the end of June.

But most important, we will be totally occupied with the National Bison Association Summer

Conference.

The Conference, which moves to s different location each year, is in Elk River, June 20-22.

The Conference will be at our farm on June 21st.
